

PUBLIC NOTICE

The Selectmen of the Town of Pawlet do hereby notify all residents of the Town of their intent to enforce the provision of 24 Vermont Statutes Annotated SubChapter 10.

Provisions of the applicable statutes are as follows:

No person shall operate, establish or maintain a junkyard unless he:

- (1) Holds a certificate of approval for the location of the junkyard;
- (2) Holds a ~~license~~ license to operate a junkyard business. ~~Added 1969, No. 98, §1.~~

A junkyard is defined as "any place of outdoor storage or deposit, whether in connection with a business or not, which is maintained, operated or used for storing, keeping, processing, buying or selling junk or as a scrap metal processing facility. However, the term does not include a private garbage dump or a sanitary landfill which is in compliance with Section 2202 of this title and the regulations of the secretary of human services. It does not mean a garage where wrecked or disabled motor vehicles are stored for less than 90 days for inspection or repairs." 24VSA §2241 (7).

"Junk" means old or scrap copper, brass, iron, steel and other old or scrap or nonferrous material, including but not limited to rope, rags, batteries, glass, rubber debris, waste, trash or any discarded, dismantled, wrecked, scrapped or ruined motor vehicles or parts thereof." 24 VSA §2241 (5)
