Discussion ensued about reducing the 12,000 square foot lot size minimum in the municipally operated sewage disposal area. Concerns were expressed about parking and quality of life and substandard housing if the lot size was reduced.

A sample application for subdivision permits was then reviewed and Jaime noted that adopting a set of density based regulations would create orderly growth for the town.
