Item 1: Meeting Minutes

Item 2: Old Business – Landfill Solar Site

The goal of any project at this site would be to maximize the benefit to the townspeople, which means examining the various financial models to determine how this can best be accomplished. First we will consult with the Select Board time to be sure that everyone is in agreement about committing to this effort. Nancy and Elizabeth would then write a summary of the various financial models.

Item 3: Old Business – PACE program (Property Assessed Clean Energy)

We need to update the status of the PACE program for encouraging homeowners to make energy improvements and also get an update on what other financial incentives are available. This information then needs to be made available to community residents. Elizabeth will pull this update together, including what VSECU offers (Vermont State Employees' Credit Union).

We talked about the timing for the fair – winter and early spring are quieter with less competing events, but not as many people are around that time of year. We also discussed weekends vs. weekdays and decided that weekends were probably better in terms of the audience, although not so good for the participating organizations such as Efficiency VT, Green Mountain Power, and NeighborWorks of Western Vermont. Another consideration would be whether to join this event with another event such as Art on the Green.

A budget for the fair and the group generally would be helpful, so that we could pay for supplies and materials and perhaps offer the speakers an honorarium. We will talk about this further and ask the Select Board about having an energy group expense as a line item in the general fund for next fiscal year.
