I-Ready Update

We will begin our winter assessment for i-ready next week. This i-ready diagnostic testing window will go from January 25th to February 12th. Our goal is to have our testing done by February 10th. The classroom teachers will be communicating with the students directly on when the testing sessions will be for the classroom. The students will take a reading and math test on two separate days. It is important that the students take the test seriously because the results will create a personalized learning path for each subject based on how the student performs. The distance learners will be taking the test with the class unless we have set up a separate time for him/her to take the test. A teacher from the school or I will communicate with you if your child is taking the i-ready test separately. Each distance learning student will be proctored by an adult for the i-ready assessment. We do not want our distance learning students taking this test by themselves. Please let me know if you have any questions.
