

Mettawee Attendance Reminders

In-Person Students

Students are expected to attend school regularly unless

- The student is sick, and the parent has communicated with the office (excused absence).
- The student had an appointment, and the parent has communicated with the office (excused absence).
- The student is required to quarantine (excused absence).
- Students who are unable to attend in-person due to illness or quarantine may access their learning remotely).

Distance/Remote Students

To be marked Present a student MUST:

- Attend their ENTIRE classroom meeting (Mon/Tues/Thurs/Fri)
- Their camera MUST be on
- They need to do their assignments and turn them in

To be marked Present on Wednesdays the student/parent MUST:

Complete the online attendance form in Clever by noon.

We need to work together to be sure in person students are attending school consistently. Having your child go to remote learning is not an option moving forward unless it falls under the statements listed above. We will mark students unexcused if they are not sick, did not go to an appointment, or if they do not need to quarantine. If your child has 5 or more unexcused absences we will need to move forward with the truancy protocol. Please communicate with the school every time your child is absent so we can mark the attendance correctly.
