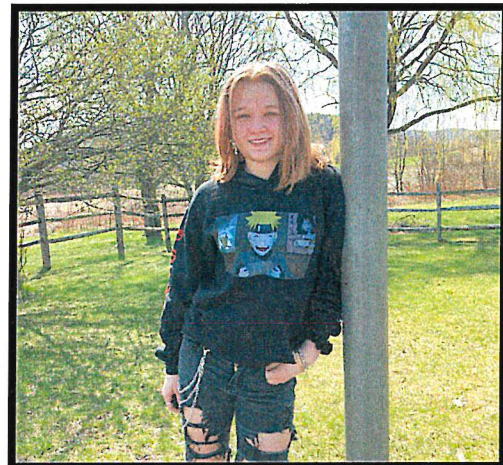

Favorite Mettawee Memory: When I was little I met Samantha in Pre-K and I went to her house. I liked going outside for exercise. I also liked All School Meetings.



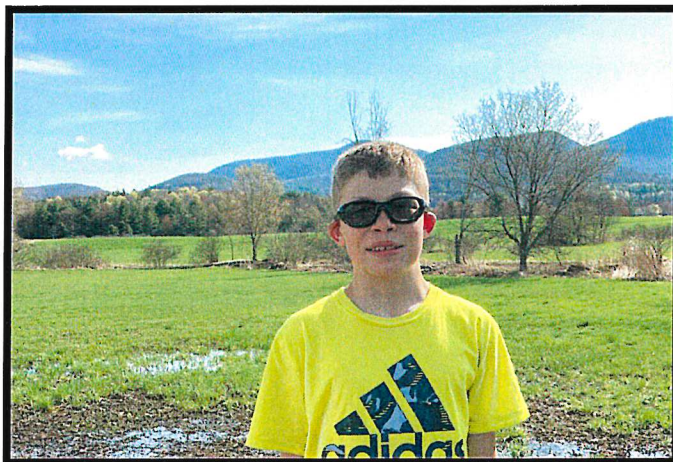
