#### Informational Calls from Mettawee

We have a system called School Messenger that we will use to make announcements for snow delays, snow closings, sporting events, and transportation updates. I want to be sure all of our families are receiving these calls and emails. Please call the school if you did not receive the phone call or email. We will be using this system to give out reminders for soccer, basketball, our school events, and bus changes. It is critical that you are on our list so you are informed about our school delays and closings this winter. If your number has changed

an email address, I highly
recommend creating a
free google email account.



I would be willing to meet with you to set up the email account so you are able to receive the important messages from our school.

#### **Bus Drivers**

Unfortunately, due to difficulty in hiring (which all of us are experiencing), it may become necessary at some point to cancel a bus route. If a driver is out sick, there is simply no one to drive that bus (the transportation and grounds directors are already driving daily routes!) I hope that this does not happen, but thought it would be better to warn you in advance of the possibility. I would like to promise you advance notice, but we all know that sickness does not come at convenient times. Please think

about alternate plans for your children's transportation in the event that we need to cancel a bus route one day. We will, of course, give you as much advance notice as possible, but it may be the morning of. Thank you for your cooperation, and I hope it does not happen!



#### **Attendance**

Please be sure to communicate with the school if your child is sick, needs to quarantine, or is waiting for test results. If your child has tested we would appreciate you forwarding your test results to us so we have them for our record. If your child is sick they will be marked as an excused absence and we will not expect the student to do any work. If your child is home based on having a symptom where they cannot come to school, but they can do school work, we will mark them present as long as they are completing the assignments. If your child has to quarantine based on being a close contact, they should be completing school work and handing it into their teacher. The classroom teachers will be communicating with you about the assignments that need to be completed. We may need a little bit of time to pull the assignments together and we will then communicate a time to come pick the assignments up. Thank you for your cooperation and patience as we are navigating these situations.


