# COVID-19 Question of the day! Answers to some Commonly asked COVID19 Questions

If someone in our household has been identified as a close contact to someone who tested positive to COVID-19 does that mean that

everyone in our household is a close contact and should stay home from school and work?

NO, only the identified close contact should quarantine and stay home from school or work.

All other family members are expected to go about their usual routine. If the person in your household who is a close contact ends up testing positive, then the rest of the household becomes close contacts and should quarantine and test.

IF YOUR
CHILD IS
SICK...

#1 - STAY HOME - if you send your child to school not feeling well (headache, stuffy nose, cough...)
we WILL send them home.

#2 - If the symptom lasts for less than 24 hours
you may send them back to school the next day. We
will be happy to have them back!

#3 - If the symptoms last for more than 24 hours EVEN IF THEY SEEM VERY MILD AND YOU WOULD
NORMALLY NOT BRING THEM TO A DOCTOR - Please
schedule a covid test or a visit to your child's
doctor. We do NOT want to see them back at school
unless they have had a covid test or have an
alternative diagnosis in writing from a doctor.

#4 - If you choose to not test - your child can return to school only after 10 full days from the onset of their symptoms.

Even if your child is feeling totally better, unless they have had a covid test, have an alternative diagnosis from a doctor, or it has been 10 days since the first day they were feeling sick, we do not want them back at school.

We are doing our very best to keep sickness out of our classrooms and to keep our school open. We thank you for your patience and cooperation.

#### All Programs

#### AGES 6, 7 - GRADES K-2 - KAP

#### JISP Instructors

Earn one credit for each day of teaching!!! One credit equals one ticket mid-week and non-holiday Sundays. Two credits in exchange for Saturdays and all holiday periods. Two free Stratton days. Free skiing from 11:00 am until 1:00 pm and after your class on the day you teach. You do need to use a credit to ski on Bromley JISP Sundays. You must commit to nine weeks of instruction.

#### JISP & KAP Drivers

Drive 3 or more JISP and/or KAP students and receive a lift ticket for \$15 on your JISP afternoon & \$20 for Bromley Sundays. All drivers must be BOC members. Shared drivers must share benefits, meaning only one can use the benefits on a given day at a time. Drivers can sign in as early as 11:00 on their JISP day. Your town chair will coordinate students.

#### 2022 Program Schedule

ALL instruction begins on Tuesday, January 4th and ends on Friday, March 11th.

ALL PROGRAMS skip TWO weeks - February 14-18 and February 21-25.

Supervised instruction is from 1-3 p.m. during the above dates.

There is no JISP or KAP supervision from 3-4 p.m.

JISP classes are not offered to High School students grades 9-12. They can take advantage of the teen student afternoon pass. Please contact Bromley for more info. The Bart Center will accept and instruct grades 9-12.

Snow day Policy - When school is cancelled due to a snow day, students may use their pass on their scheduled program day of the week. Drivers will need to buy a regular priced pass and instructors must use a credit. No programs/lessons if school is cancelled. There are no makeup days.

<u>KAP</u> – All students must come up to the ticket office to get their photo taken and pick up their pass. **NO preprinted** passes are available.

#### JISP - You have 2 choices....

1. Photo on file – If you have a photo on file from last year you can choose to use last season's photo. Your pass will be sent to your school through your town chair. You will receive a NEW pass – please do not use last years pass.

2. New photo – If you do not have a photo on file, have not gotten a pass in the past, or never been in KAP or JISP then passes are available for pickup during the times below.

November 26 - December 1 from 12:30 - 4:00

Must pick up passes before December 1 or be charged \$20.00

December 2 through opening, Mon. - Fri. 9:00 until 3:30, Sunday's 1 - 4

#### LATE FEE

You must come pick up your pass before December 1 or you will be charged a late fee of \$20 and you will not be taken in line before a season pass holder.

December 2 – Opening

Mon-Fri: 9:00 - 3:30 Sunday: 1-4

(\$20 late fee applies!!!!!) **NO JISP Pass Cards Issued after December 1 on Saturdays.** There is a \$10 replacement fee for lost Pass Cards at Bromley customer service.

#### **Equipment Rentals**

#### **KAP & JISP**

All JISP/KAP rentals are now pickup only, you may not take them home. JISP/KAP rentals are \$120 with no deposit required. If you desire to take them home, you will need to purchase a regular seasonal rental for \$220 plus a \$100 deposit.

You must come to a fitting.

#### Rental Fitting & Sizing Days @ Rentals

November 25 – December 24 – Everyday 8:30 – 4:30 December 21/22 – Afternoon only 12:00 – 4:30 Fitting will not be available December 25 – January 1

#### LATE FEE

You must get fitted before your first day of rentals or you will be charged a late fee of \$20. This includes scholarship students.
