

Winter Sports Update



We have received the winter guidance from the Agency of Education. The state strongly recommends all eligible student athletes get vaccinated. Any unvaccinated student athletes will need to be tested weekly in order to

participate in playing a winter sport. Keeping track of weekly testing for each unvaccinated student will be a lot to manage for grades K-6. Based on this, we will only be offering basketball to Mettawee students in grades 3-6. Masks will be worn by all student athletes, coaches, referees, and spectators during indoor practices and games, regardless of individual vaccination status.

We will be starting basketball practices in January. This gives our families time to get their children vaccinated before participating in basketball. If you do not plan on getting your child vaccinated, and they want to play basketball, you will need to have your child tested each week with a PCR test. The results will be submitted each Friday in order for your child to participate in basketball practices and games the following week.

The student sign up sheet will be in Big Blue today for 3-6 grade students. Please fill out the sheet before November 19th. We are hoping to figure out how many students would like to participate in basketball in grades 3-6. We will also be recruiting basketball coaches. These details will be determined by mid-December. Basketball practices and games will be scheduled from January to the end of February. Let Brooke DeBonis or Janna Webb know if you have any questions about Mettawee's Basketball program.

COVID-19 Question of the week!

Answers to some Commonly asked COVID19 Questions

* Is it important to have my child tested for covid-19 right away if they are not feeling well and have been at school?

YES - is the short answer! If your child becomes ill with any symptoms that could potentially be covid-19 - and has been at school - we will need to know as soon as possible whether their illness is covid related or not. If your child's test comes back positive we will need to begin the process of identifying close contacts and potentially beginning quarantines. If you wait to test, we will miss the window of identifying close contacts and risk the chance of classroom spread. Once classroom spread happens, it's a slippery slope to community spread. It is so important for us to know right away of a positive case if we hope to keep our classrooms and our school open for full time, in person learning. Please work with us to keep everyone safe.

Likewise, if your child has been identified as a close contact to someone who tested positive for covid-19, please keep your child home and contact the school right away so we can be prepared for the possibility of a positive case. If you have kept them home, it is quite possible that the school will not be impacted at all. That is a best case scenario!

IF YOUR CHILD IS SICK...

#1 - STAY HOME - if you

send your child to school not feeling well (headache, stuffy nose, cough...) we WILL send them home.

#2 - If the symptom lasts for less than 24 hours
you may send them back to school the next day. We
will be happy to have them back!

#3 - If the symptoms last for more than 24 hours EVEN IF THEY SEEM VERY MILD AND YOU WOULD
NORMALLY NOT BRING THEM TO A DOCTOR - Please
schedule a covid test or a visit to your child's
doctor. We do NOT want to see them back at school
unless they have had a covid test or have an

#4 - If you choose to not test - your child can return to school only after 10 full days from the onset of their symptoms.

alternative diagnosis in writing from a doctor.

Even if your child is feeling totally better, unless they have had a covid test, have an alternative diagnosis from a doctor, or it has been 10 days since the first day they were feeling sick, we do not want them back at school.

We are doing our very best to keep sickness out of our classrooms and to keep our school open. We thank you for your patience and cooperation.
