Save the Dates

We will be starting our SBAC testing for students in grades 3-6 in April. The SBAC test is a statewide



test that focuses on Math and English Language Arts. The math section will occur on April 5th, 6th, and 7th. The ELA section will take place on April 11th, 12th, 13th and 14th. The students will be testing for about 90 minutes of each of these days. We break the test up into small sessions so the students feel less overwhelmed. We will be testing in the mornings and the classes will continue to have recess and their specials. Some of the specials will take place at a different time, but they will still have them on the assigned day of the week. Please try your best to not schedule appointments and trips during these two weeks. Our goal is to have all the SBAC tests completed before April break. Thank you for your cooperation and understanding.



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


