## **Principal's Corner:**

#### **Attendance**

It is important that you call the school by 8:15 to let us know why your child is absent. If we do not hear from you, we will mark your child as an UNEXCUSED absence. If your child has missed 5 unexcused days of school, the trancy protocol needs to be followed. After the 5th unexcused absence, we will need to have a meeting to develop a plan to help you to get your child to school. After the 7th unexcused missed day, the truant officer will be notified and he will be contacting you. Our goal is to have your child successfully in school so they can learn and develop relationships with the staff and students.

If your child does not feel well, please call the school or email Heidi Hammell, Cheryl Chalmers, and your classroom teacher to let us know and it will be marked as an EXCUSED absence. Please take the time to communicate with the school about your child's absences.



## **Bus Expectations**

Please take a moment to remind your child of the bus expectations. I would like to have a safe and calm bus ride for all of our students. The bus drivers are noticing some students are not listening to their directions and they are not being safe.

## Mettawee Bus Safety Rules

- 1. Stay facing forward in your seat while the bus is in motion.
- 2. Use quiet voices.
- 3. Be respectful to your friends and the bus driver.
- 4. Keep hands and feet to yourself.
- 5. Stay out of the aisle and sit with your backs against the seat.
- 6. Please do not eat or drink on the bus.
- 7. Always listen to the bus driver's directions.
  - If your child is being disruptive and disrespectful they will lose the privilege of riding the school bus.
  - If the bus needs to turn around based on your child's behavior, they will be asked to get off the bus and you will need to come to Mettawee to pick them up.
  - The bus drivers will be writing tickets when the students are not following these rules.
  - If your child gets two tickets, they will be off the bus for a period of time.




