


given all the proceeds from this fundraiser. The donation box will be in the front lobby for one week.

Also, thank you to the Modern Woodmen of Wells for the use of the dunk tank - and to all the brave volunteer teachers who put themselves in the seat


volunteer teachers who put themselves in the seat to be plunged at the hands of our students!
