
Principal's Corner:

Parent Permission for School Counseling Mettawee Community School (802) 645-9009

Dear Parent(s)/Guardian(s):

I hope you and your family have had a restful and relaxing summer vacation! As we welcome in the beginning of the 2022-2023 school year I wanted to let you know what supports I will be providing this year as the school counselor, and how you may be able to access these services for your child(ren).

I have the privilege to work with every single student in the school. This year I will be working with students at the classroom level, small group level, as well as at the short-term individual counseling level. I will also be meeting with parents, collaborating with teachers and staff, and consulting with community organizations to benefit and meet the needs of all Mettawee students.

Classroom Guidance Lessons (Social Emotional Learning-SEL) These lessons will be presented in the classroom for students in grades K-6. Lessons will teach developmentally appropriate, preventative lessons to all children. Topics will include communication, friendship skills, conflict resolution, and bullying, among others.

Group Counseling-Group counseling is provided for small groups of students experiencing similar concerns. These may include making and keeping friends, anger management, coping with separation/divorce and or loss, getting organized/study skills and/or improving self-esteem. The groups generally range from 4 to 6 students and last for 6 to 8 sessions. The students for these groups can be recommended by parents/guardians or by staff members.

Individual Counseling- This year I will also offer short term one-on-one counseling support to students in grades K to 6. Students may self-refer or be referred to the counselors by teachers/staff and/or parents. Confidentiality is respected.

If you feel that your student is in need of counseling support, please begin the process by contacting your child's teacher. We will then collaborate and discuss the best course of action regarding support for your child. Some students will benefit from quick check-ins, while others may need to be referred to an outside counselor. We work collaboratively with Kristie LeVitre to provide longer ongoing support of students and their families through outside therapy.

If you have any questions please reach out. I am always here to listen and provide support.

I look forward to a great school year and working with you and your family!


