
Principal's Corner:



Dear Families,

Based on the increased need for students to gain more support socially and emotionally, I have decided to change the role of Mrs. Jennings, our school counselor at Mettawee Community School. Mrs. Jennings will be working at Sunderland a day and a half starting next week, as a result we will have her for three and a half days each week. Based on this shift, I realized that Mrs. Jennings would not have enough time to meet with our students in small groups or individually if she continued to teach guidance classes for grades K-6.

Rather than teaching guidance classes to all students in grades K-6 once a week, she will be available to support individual, small group, and whole classes throughout the day. This flexibility will assist our school in supporting the students who need a person to listen and guide them when they are struggling. My hope is that Mrs. Jennings will be able to connect with more students and be able to meet with the classroom teachers more often to support the classes as the need arises. Based on this change, you may get an email or phone call from Mrs. Jennings to discuss social situations that she will be processing with our students. Developing this tiered systems of support for our students, will allow me to work on the instructional leadership practices vs handling all the student behavior concerns on a daily basis.

We will teach the social and emotional skills in the classrooms as well as in the unified arts classes each day. We plan on having monthly themes of values that we plan to announce in All-School Meetings and they will be taught by all the staff in the building. I wanted to share the themes with you so you can support teaching these values at home.
