

- 1. Fill out applicant/owner contact information.
- 2. Property location: E911 address, zoning district, parcel/tax map #, block and lot. Contact Pawlet E911 coordinator to confirm address
- Describe current and proposed use of the structure and work to be done. A sketch plan of property and proposed work must accompany permit application. (see site plan sample)
- For new construction, a plot plan with road frontage or right of way from public or private road, location of septic and water. Location of work relative to all property lines.
- 5. For an addition, a plot plan and a scale drawing are required.
- Submit 2 copies of completed application with supporting documents along with applicable fees and \$15 recording fee to the Zoning Administrator.
- Permits are subject to a 15 day appeal period by any interested party. The permit is not valid until the 15 day period has passed. Permits are valid for 2 years.

- All construction must comply with The Vermont Residential Building Energy Standards (RBES). Certification must be filed with the Vermont Public Service Department and The Pawlet Town Clerk http://publicservice.vermont.gov.

Allowable Density & Density Remaining	\$300
