



Who should attend?

Children ages 2 ½ - 5 years old that reside in Danby, Dorset, Landgrove, Londonderry, Manchester, Mt. Tabor, Pawlet, Peru, Rupert, Sunderland, Seton, and Winhall are invited to participate in the BRSU annual developmental screenings.

What is developmental screening?

The goal of an early childhood screening is to assess development in the areas of social emotional learning, speech and language, problem solving, fine motor and gross motor skills. Early Childhood Educators will observe your child in a play based format. Families will then receive feedback about their child's development.
