# **Vermont State Assessments (VTCAP) Dates:**

This year the state of Vermont has shifted the vendor for the statewide assessment system from the Smarter Balanced Assessment Consortium (SBAC) to Cognia and has begun referring to the assessments (ELA, Math, Science, and Alternative Assessment) as the Vermont Comprehensive Assessment Program (VTCAP).

While the name of the vendor has changed, it is important to note that testing expectations have remained. This means that students in grades 3-6 are expected to test in the areas of ELA and Mathematics with 5th grades also completing a Science assessment. The tests remain computer adaptive and the content and student experience should be familiar to students who have completed SBAC in the past.

We will be conducting the VT Science
Assessment for 5th grade on April 12th and
13th. Students in grades 3-6 will be taking the
English Language Arts (ELA) assessment on
May 2nd-4th. Students will then take the math
assessment May 9th-12th. We will not need
that many days for the ELA and math
assessments, but we will use that week in case
we have any students who need more time or

to make up a session that they missed. I will be sending home a separate letter with more information on this assessment in April. I just wanted to be sure you were aware of the dates so we can make sure your child is present to take the assessment.



Friday, March 17th will now be a student day of school to make up for the double snow

days this week.


