On the last day of school we will dismiss students at 12:30 (Friday, June 16th). The Extravaganza is back! Our Staff will be


























Dear Mettawee Band Students and Families,

Thank you for a wonderful concert! It felt so good to showcase our students on stage. We had a slow start and lots of hurdles to cross mid-year but the progress and enthusiasm was obvious and exciting. I'm really proud of our musicians.

Please carefully review the following information about your instrument:

If your instrument was provided through the school:

All students who are using school-owned instruments must return the instruments and books to Ms. Hoyt by **FRIDAY**, **JUNE 9**.

If you rented an instrument through Ellis Music or John Keal Music Company:

If you plan to play in band next year, I strongly recommend that you continue renting throughout the summer months. Summertime is a great time to learn new music, especially on rainy days or to entertain family and friends. When school starts in the fall, we will begin band rehearsals in early September. You will be ready to start right away and will not need to order an instrument or sign a new contract. Your rental payments will continue to accumulate toward owning the instrument. These companies also offer buy-out options at affordable rates for customers in good standing.

If you plan to return your instrument to the music company you must call the company to cancel your contract and arrange pick-up at the school. After June 15th, you will be responsible for any returns and possible shipping to the company.
